KEYS TO A GREAT ORGANIZATION AND PROGRAM

CULTURE COMES FIRST: If you haven't created an underlying ecosystem of excellence, short-term success is all it ever will be.

PRESS EVERY EDGE ALL THE TIME, BECAUSE ANY EDGE MAY MATTER ANYTIME: The focus is on the details, so you have to have that focus not because they know when it will matter but because they <u>don't</u> know when it will matter.

SYSTEM OVER STARS: Talent matters, but willingness to buy into the program matters more.

LEADERSHIP IS A LONG-TERM PROPOSITION: True leaders always value sustainable success over quick fixes. Ignore all distractions for short term gains if you are convinced that a decision is best for the long term success of the program.

YOU'RE NEVER DONE GETTING BETTER: Growth over time requires finding new ways to do the same old things. Real leaders are never done learning.
